General Rules

You may submit to multiple categories: Pop/Rock/EDM/Hip-Hop, Country/Folk/Americana, and Film/TV/Sync. The submission deadline is **September 15**, **2020** and categories will be limited to 200 submissions each. We will select the top five songs from both the Pop and Country category to share directly with A&R teams from the industry's top music publishers and record labels. The ultimate winner will receive free registration to an upcoming Expo, including a live showcase at the event. The winner selected from the Film/TV category will receive free registration to the next Durango Film/TV Expo, also including a live showcase. The Film/TV category includes songs that have to be of master quality production, otherwise, the music supervisors can't use it. Also, each entry will have to be easily cleared for licensing. Applicants under the age of 18 **must** have permission from a parent or guardian to submit.

Song submission does not guarantee that your song will be heard by the listed music industry representatives, only that it will be considered; similarly, getting your song sent to music industry representatives does not guarantee that your song will be "placed" or "cut".
