SINGER/SONGWRITER SHOWCASE

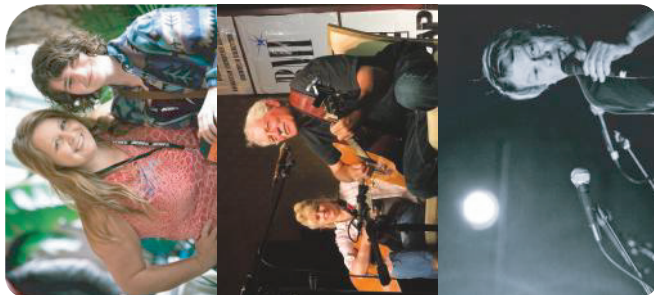
